As per the audited Accounts, result of the current year shows Net Surplus of Rs. 2,00,180/-, out of which Rs. 1,50,000/- has been transferred to the benevolent fund. I must thank the entire managing committee for unanimously accepting my proposal to transfer an amount of Rs. 1,50,000/- to strengthen the benevolent fund corpus.

This is the first time in 66 years of activities of our Bar a new amount of Rs. 10 lacs has been added to the investments. Amount of fixed deposit has rise to the tune of Rs. 91,72,000/- in FY 2012-13 as against Rs. 81,72,000/- in FY 2011-12.
